<b>Note #1</b> ) Sole surviving US Navy Patrol Air Cushion Vehicle (PACV): Served in combat alongside 6665 – the “Ugly Duckling” in 1968 Perfume River Mobile Base One. PACV now owned by Yanks Air Museum, Chino, CA.					
<b>Note #2</b> ) MKII, Kenner, LA (New Orleans) Purchased – for parts - by Dave Pizzoferrato one year after Hurricane Katrina. Hull was donated to a veterans group who wanted one for a static display. After selling hull 7329 and acquiring the Modutech hull from Larry Steever, all parts were transferred back to the Kenner group to complete the Kenner/Katrina PBR – one boat. It is now a static display at the Naval Memorial Park in Kenner. It had been formerly displayed at the Naval Reserve Base on Lake Ponchartrain. The Kenner group claims the hull number was 6829 but it had been cut out and no such markings were found when it was being stripped for parts.					
<b>Note #3</b> ) MKI boats were manufactured only during fiscal year 1966 and were numbered 31RP661 through 31RP66161. MKII boats were built starting in 1967 with 31RP671 through September 1980, with two (2) un-numbered hulls being built.					
<b>Note #4</b> ) All boats marked “as of Oct. 1975” are known to be at that location at that time, & were taken from the “Structural Failures in the U.S. Navy PBR Fleet”. report of the date.

<b>Note #6</b> ) According to the “Naval Sea Combat Systems Engineering Station” (NSCSES), in report 60-258, 1991 there were six (6) River City Machine works hulls were made to be replacement hulls, and all stored at SBU XI, Mare Island.
